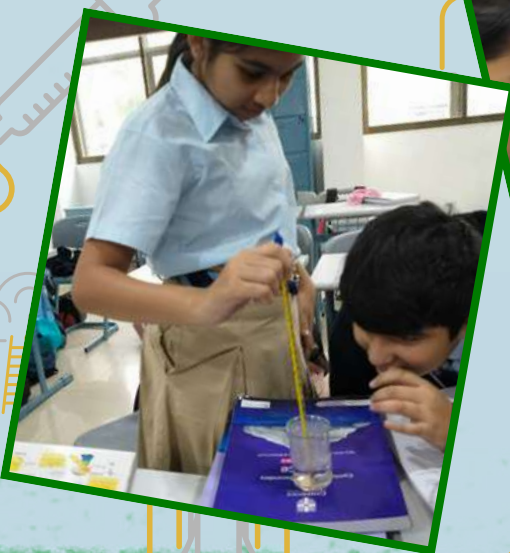
Hands-on Science: Student Discoveries



Measuring the lung volume
